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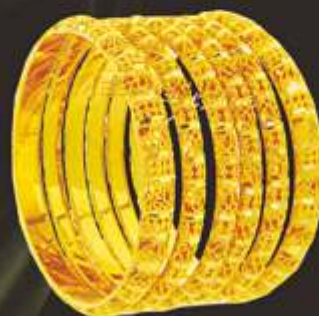
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Self ESTEEM

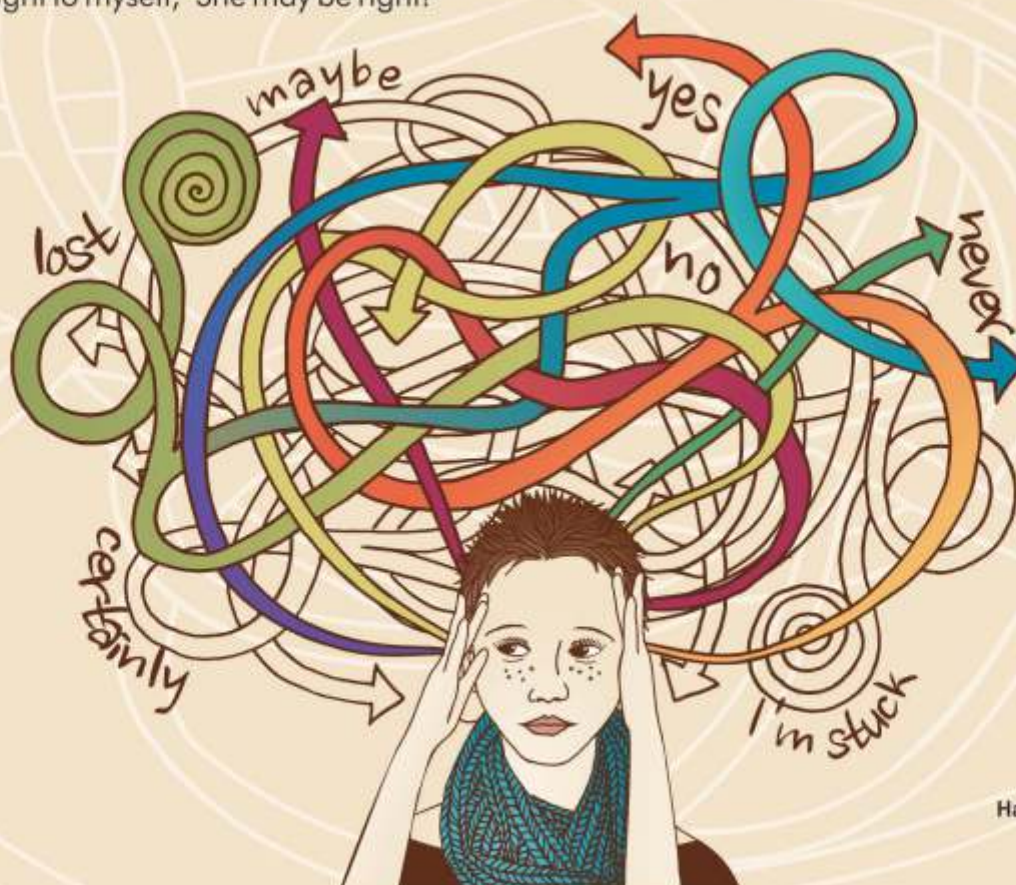
Take a Look at Your GOOD TIMES

Look at what you have left. Don't look at what you've lost. Look at your good times — don't look at your bad times.

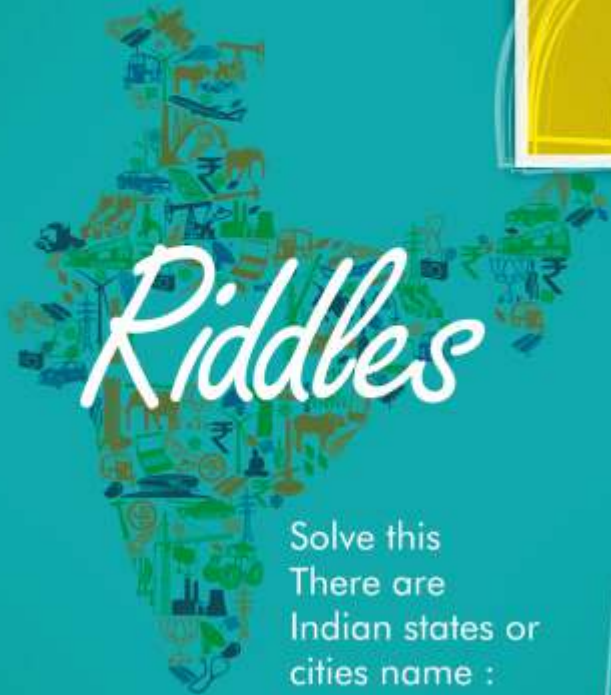

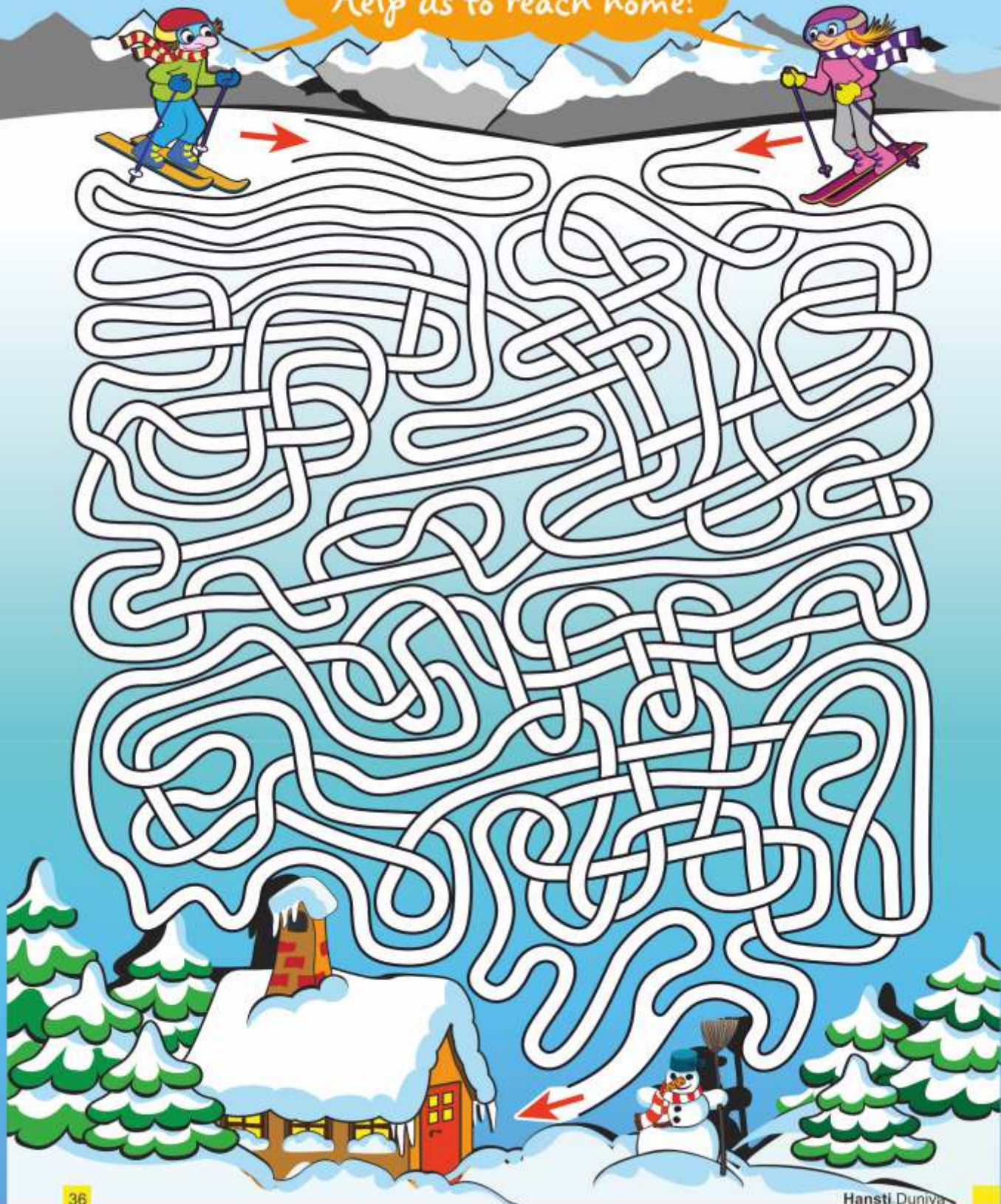
