
Increasing age and, excessive use of medicines also leads to the symptom of 'dryness'. Some people have this symptom of dry eyes since birth.

Some people feel that an external speck of dust has entered their eyes and is disturbing them. Some experience itchiness and inflammation while some can't bear light. Some experience heaviness of eyelids while others feel pain in their eyes. These are all symptoms of dryness in eyes.

Sometimes a person does not have sufficient tears in his eyes or sometimes they are equal to none. The phenomenon of eyes not getting soaked in itself is called 'dryness' .In fact a layer of tears is immediately formed as soon as one blinks. This protects the eyes from dust and keeps them lubricated.

Dryness can be aggravated by pollen and grains and is also caused by deficiency of vitamin A. In the absence of timely medical help a wound can result in the eyes which can deteriorate to an ulcer harming the retina (the screen in eye). It may result in blindness.

Those who watch too much T.V. or work on computers also complain of dryness of eyes; because frequently blinking of eyes decreases in front of T.V. or computer screen. The minimum frequency required is once in 20 seconds.

'Lambu' the camel and 'Tendhu' giraffe took over and presented a beautiful 'Jhumru' dance.







Walnuts can be easily incorporated into our diet as they can be eaten as such or added to many different foods. Despite being high in fat they have a number of health and weight benefits.

- Chronic conditions related to heart and blood vessels commonly called cardiovascular diseases can be controlled by regular intake of this nut.
- 2. Walnuts have several bioactive compounds like phytosterols, omega 3 fatty acids and various antioxidants that can help keep cancer away.



- 3. Coincidentally the cover of walnut resembles the human brain. Studies have shown that this healthy nut can help with age related decline in brain function. It can also slow down the. progress of alzheimer's disease.
- 4. Omega 3 fatty acids that are essential for healthy eyes are contained in walnuts. Therfore they protect the eyes from a variety of vision problems.
- 5. Walnuts are a rich source of serotonin, a chemical in the brain that helps as a mood booster making us feel calm and relaxed.

6. It can control diabetes. Walnuts are rich in dietary fibres that take a lot of time to digest. So sugar is released slowly in the blood.

7. Walnuts are rich source of mineral copper which is known to improve bone density. It also helps in maintaining collagen which helps in forming our bone. Minerals magnesium and manganese contained in this precious nut improve bone health.


8. Adding walnut oil to salad can make us feel full. This helps the body fight its craving for fats, hence it can help in maintaining weight.



Abraham Lincoln

A braham Lincoln, 16th president of the United States from 1861-1865 was born on February 12, 1809 in Larue County, Kentucky, in USA in a log cabin to parents who could neither read nor write.

Libcoln was self educated. He educated himself by reading borrowed books and did not have the opportunity to go to college. He had to work constantly to support his family. As a young adult he worked as a store keeper, soldier, surveyor and postmaster.

In 1831 he moved to the town of New Salem, Illinois, where he joined the job of a clerk in a general store. There he came to know about local people all around because of his ability to read and write. He also became popular among the young because of his good nature and integrity.

There he contested for the seat of state legislature as an independent candidate. He lost the seat and started concentrating on studying law on his own. He got his license for practicing law in 1867 and handled routine legal work for small fee to supplement his meagre salary.



In 1834 he won the seat of state legislature. In 1860 he took over the office of president. Lincoln's 1863 'Emancipation Proclamation' gave legal freedom to 3.5 million slaves then held at Confederate territory (US states that warred against the United States during the American Civil War). He was also actively involved in the amendment in U.S. constitution which made slavery unconstitutional.

Abraham Lincoln is held in high regards for his accomplishments and personal characteristics. He is remembered fondly because of his character qualities. He was not born with these qualities rather practiced and honed them slowly. He learned from his mistakes. Even as president he treated others with honesty, humility, courage, justice and grace. He believed that all people deserve equal treatment. Honesty, leadership, hard work, empathy, humility, courage and responsibility are some of the virtues that he always worked on. These character qualities of a president who rose from poverty to such a high position must be amalgamated into every society. **



Before the soldiers could follow the queen's orders the fairies ran fast. The





soldiers followed them. The fairies threw the water and the pots on the Earth. The places where the pots fell, became five ponds of sweet water.

Seeing this, the genie again begged, "Let me out please. I won't harm you at all."


"How can I believe you? I saved your life and you were going to eat me up," retorted the lad.



- Showcase all accomplishments in Science for the well being of humans.





Q. What is a glacier?

A. A glacier is moving 'river' of ice. Glaciers are found in polar regions and in high mountains, wherever more snow falls in winter than is lost through melting and evaporation in summer. The icy mass creeps slowly downhill. Glaciers shape landscapes, When a galcier reaches the sea in very cold negions, huge blocks of ice break off to form floating icebergs. The largest icebergs in the world are found in the coean around Antarctica.

Q. Why are high mountain tops covered in snow?

A. High mountain tops are surrounded by very cold air. for every 1,000 metres in height, the temperature falls by 5 degrees Celsius. The highest mountains are snow-covered all year round. The highest mountains in the world are found in long ranges such as the Himalayas (Asia), the Andes (South America), the Rockies (North Amerca) and the Alps (Europe.)

Q. How can we tell stalactites from stalagmites?

A. Stalactites and stalagmites form inside limestone caves. The water that drips steadily from the roof contains a mineral called calite. The water dries, but the calcite remains and slowly builds into a column. Stalactites grow downwards, from the cave roof.

Stalagmites grow upwards, from the cace floor. Sometimes the two columns meet to form a pillar.








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
